

ORDER

Sub: Retention of Laptop by the officers of All India Services, officers of State Government and Judicial Officers at the time of their retirement or on leaving the service.

Retention of allotted laptops by District Judge level judicial officer at the time of retirement / leaving the service was allowed with the concurrence of Finance Department by depositing amount as per standard rate of depreciation in accordance with Income Tax Rules.


Similar demand has been raised by other judicial officers of the State.

Keeping in view the rapid advancement and obsolescence in computer technology, the matter regarding retention of laptop on depreciated residual value at the time of retirement or leaving the service was considered by the Government for all the officers of State Government.

After due consideration, it has been decided that all the officers of All India Services, Officers of State Government and all the Judicial Officers including District Judge level Officers, who are entitled to or allowed laptops, may be allowed to retain the laptops at the time of their retirement or on leaving the service with the following conditions :

- (i) The rate of depreciation shall be 30%, 25%, 20%, 15% and 5% for the first 5 years respectively.
- (ii) The laptop shall be owned by the State Government till such time, the officer deposits its residual value and takes ownership of the same as laid-down in this order.
- (iii) For this purpose laptop shall include laptop, note-book, i-pad and tablet.

CLARIFICATION

Sub: Retention of Laptop by the officers of All India Services, officers of State Government and Judicial Officers at the time of their retirement or on leaving the service.

Ref: Finance Department order of even number dated 4-3-2014.

Vide Finance Department's order referred above, officers of All India Services, Officers of State Government and Judicial Officers, including District Judge level Officers, were allowed to retain the laptops at the time of their retirement or on leaving the service with certain conditions.

It is clarified that rate of depreciation mention in the above order is as per the straight line depreciation method. Accordingly, the residual value of the laptop over the service life period shall be as under :

Depreciated, i.e. residual value after the end of year(s)					Residual value at any point of time beyond end of 5th year	Reference for calculating residual value
Year 1	Year 2	Year 3	Year 4	Year 5		
70%	45%	25%	10%	5%	5%	percentage of purchase price

For the purpose of calculating the depreciated value, the price of the Laptop, including licensed OS will be taken into account only. The depreciation formula does not include any packaged utility software bought along with the machine as separate item.

For calculating depreciation for a part of the year, proportionate depreciation prescribed for that year can be divided by 12 for arriving at a value for a particular month within that year. This shall be proportionally added to the cumulative depreciation prior to that year, to arrive at the final depreciation. By way of illustration, the residual value where a part year is involved, say, at the end of 15 months from the date of purchase will be as under :

- i) Assumed Original purchase cost = Rs. 50,000/-
- ii) Depreciation after 1st year = 30%
- iii) Depreciation after 15 months = Depreciation for the first year (@30% of purchase price in first year) + depreciation for 3 months of second year (@25% of purchase price for second year) = $30\% + (25\% \times 3/12) = 36.25\%$ of purchase price.
- iv) Residual value after 15 months = Original Cost — Depreciation after 15 months = Rs. 50,000 — $(36.25/100 \times \text{Rs. } 50,000) = \text{Rs. } 31,875/-$

Sub: Retention of Laptop by the officers of All India Services, officers of State Government and Judicial Officers at the time of their retirement or on leaving the service.

Ref: Finance Department Order of even number dated 4-3-2014 and Clarification dated 20-3-2014.

Vide Finance Department's order and clarification referred above, officers of All India Services, Officers of State Government and Judicial Officers, including District Judge level Officers, were allowed to retain the laptops at the time of their retirement or on leaving the service with certain conditions.

The matter was reconsidered and para 4(i) of the FD Order dated 4-3-2014 is replaced as follows:


"The rate of depreciation shall be 30%, 25%, 20%, 15%, 5%, 2%, 1% and 1% for the first 8 years respectively"

Accordingly the residual value of the laptop over the service life period as clarified in FD Clarification dated 20-3-2014 is revised as under:

ORDER

Sub: Allowing serving officers of All India Services, State Services and Judicial Officers to retain old laptop given to them in official capacity after depositing residual value.

Keeping in view the rapid advancement and obsolescence in computer technology, the matter regarding retention of laptop on depreciated residual value has been considered by the Government for all the officers of State Government.


After due consideration, it has been decided to allow serving officers of All India Services, State Services and Judicial Officers including District Judge level officers to retain old laptop given to them in official capacity after depositing residual value and as per following conditions:

- (i) Officers of All India Services, Officers of State Government and Judicial Officers still in service and to whom Laptop in official capacity is allotted may be allowed retention of Laptop if it is 5 years or more old.
- (ii) Depreciated or residual value for retention of Laptop will be as follows:

Depreciated, i.e. residual value after end of years				Residual value at the end of 9 year and any point of time beyond 9 th Year	Reference for calculating residual value
Year 5	Year 6	Year 7	Year 8		
20%	15%	10%	5%	1%	Percentage of purchase price

- (iii) Officers who opt for retention of old Laptop as per this scheme and after depositing residual value, may be issued new official Laptop.
- (iv) The Laptop shall be owned by the State Government till such time, the officer deposits its residual value and takes ownership of the same as laid down in this Order.
- (v) For this purpose laptop shall include laptop, note-book, i-pad and tablet.
